

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT
FOR LANDMARK COMMUNICATIONS, INC. GROUP HEALTH PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of the Landmark Communications, Inc. Group Health Plan, EIN 54-0321115, Plan No. 501, for period January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Landmark Communications, Inc. & Subsidiaries has committed itself to pay certain medical, surgical and hospitalization and dental claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Connecticut General Life Insurance Company and Vision Service Plan to pay certain stop loss and vision insurance claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2007 were \$1,339,667.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2007, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$389,345 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these experience-rated contracts during the plan year was \$307,048.
