The Navy isn't the only branch of the military to call Hampton Roads home, more than 159,000 people work for the Navy, Army, Air Force, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard to make Hampton Roads the largest military market in the U.S. Together, they represent 13% of the market's adult population and 17% of the workforce.
